REPORT OF ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE 2016-17

Anti-Ragging Committee for the Year 2016-17, formed under the Chairmanship of Principal and Dean, Prof.(Dr.) U.S.Krishna Nayak.

- 23 Committee members and 11 Student representatives attended the very first meeting on 7th September 2016.
- Agenda of the Meeting was to discuss the measures being taken to prevent ragging in our Institution/Campus and enforce protocols, steps to safe guard the newly admitted Students of Ist BDS.
- “Orientation Day” for Ist BDS Students was held on 19th September 2016. Freshers were made to sign the undertaking of annexure I, II, III and IV which was attached to their diary book in order to fulfil the requirement. .
- As per the Directions of UGC/MHRD online undertaking was done by the Students and their parents /Guardian by filling up the compliance at WWW.antiragging.in in order to curb the menace of ragging in higher educational Institution.
- Senior Students were also made to submit their online undertaking with a hard copy signed by the Students and their parents. A Separate file has been maintained in the College Office for the same.
- Senior Staff Members were given the charge as “Anti Ragging Squad” which has helped us to ensure students safety and welfare in the Hostel, Campus and the Surrounding areas.
- Anti Ragging Committee and the squad made sufficient Visits to both the boys and girls hostels at any given time (A file has been maintained in the College office of their visit as squad/committee members).
- A workshop was organized on 23rd September 2017 regarding awareness about the ills of ragging amongst the Students and members of the Anti ragging Committee /Squad by a member of the Dental Council of the India from Karnataka.
- Senior Students were made aware of the legal consequences of ragging and misconduct. Dr. Sanjeev M Patil, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime and Traffic, Mangalore City addressed the Senior and Junior Students on 2nd November 2016 with

respect to Ragging, its repercussions, rights of victims of ragging and the duties of Educational Institutions and that Ragging was a nonbailable offence.

- A separate “early mess” arrangements were made for the newly joined students in both the Hostels. Separate bus arrangements were made available for the pick and drop of the new comers for attending classes from Dental to Medical College.
- Prior permission from the Dean has to be taken in case of going out or coming late to the Hostel, and is being entered in the students log Book.
- Posters , Rules and regulations of Anti ragging are put up in and around the College area like Notice Board, Departments, Common room, Canteen, Library and Hostels etc to generate awareness amongst Students on Anti-Ragging.
